

**A Resolution of the Joint Committee of the Interagency Working  
Group for Public Transportation Services and the Public  
Transportation Advisory Council**

WHEREAS, Idaho Code 40-514 (c) gives responsibilities to the Interagency Working Group for Public Transportation Services "to advise and assist . . . In analyzing public transportation needs, identifying areas for coordination, and developing strategies for eliminating procedural and regulatory barriers to coordination at the state level"; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Joint Committee to effectively utilize all available funding for mobility services in Idaho; and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest for all Idaho State Agencies to promote and maintain healthy lifestyles and to encourage the usage of active transportation; and

WHEREAS, *Complete Streets* are integral to providing safe and efficient mobility options for Idaho citizens; and

WHEREAS, incorporating health into transportation policies and infrastructure provides for a more vibrant community; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Welfare is currently managing projects for i) Healthy Communities and ii) Complete Streets; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Welfare is conducting these two projects in support of healthy vibrant communities with safe, competitive, and efficient mobility options; and

WHEREAS, coordination with all agencies and representatives on the Joint Committee will be necessary for effective conduct of these two projects;

*NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED*, that the Joint Committee of the Interagency Working Group for Public Transportation Services and the Public Transportation Advisory Council acknowledges and endorses the Healthy Communities and Complete Streets projects being conducted by the Department of Health and Welfare. Member agencies of the Joint Committee authorize their staffs to support and assist this project and consider and participate in outcomes and recommendations resulting from this project.
